Last Minute Help at End of 2014 Tax Season

Denver, CO – The Denver Asset Building Coalition (DABC) will be offering extended hours on Monday, April 14th and Tuesday, April 15th for last-minute tax filers. Come get your taxes done for **free** with DABC and our trained and experienced tax preparers! DABC is open from 1pm to 9pm on Monday and 9am to 9pm on Tuesday.

“We encourage people to come see us before the big rush, but every year we see people on deadline day who really appreciate the extra help,” said Angie Schmitz, DABC Board President. “We are THE go-to free tax site in Denver though, so you can count on us right to the end.”

DABC services are available to households that earned less than \$52,000 in 2013. Services available on April 14th and April 15th include filing of 2013 federal and state income tax returns, help with filing federal extension requests and free KeyBank checking accounts.

Crunch Day is a partnership of DABC, the IRS, KeyBank and the City and County of Denver, as well as our other partners, the Mi Casa Resource Center and mpowered.
