### **DABC Offers Extended Tax Preparation Services**

Services include filing prior year and amended returns, purchasing savings bonds

March 13, 2009 – The Denver Asset Building Coalition (DABC) is offering extended services during March at its two Tax SuperSites, which are free to households earning less than \$45,000. Besides enabling clients to electronically file 2008 federal and Colorado tax returns, DABC helps low-income individuals and families file amended returns and prior year taxes (back to 2005), and purchase savings bonds. Services are available at the King Trimble Center and Wells Fargo in Aurora during convenient after-work and weekend hours.

“People who have not yet filed 2005 returns have until April 15, 2009 to file and claim any refund,” said Brian Cotter, DABC Board of Directors President. “DABC helps clients file their 2005 through 2008 tax returns to ensure low-income families claim all the credits and refunds they are entitled to. We’ll be doing amended and prior year returns during the entire month of March.” According to the Internal Revenue Service, 23,700 people in Colorado have failed to claim \$20.7 million because they have not yet filed their 2005 returns.

“We’re also enabling clients to amend their 2008 or prior year returns to claim credits like the Earned Income Tax Credit which they may have not known about before,” continued Cotter. “If people believe they may not have claimed all the credits and deductions they are eligible for, they can come see us, file an amended return, and ensure they’re maximizing their refund.”

Individuals may also wish to file an amended 2008 return in order to take advantage of Economic Stimulus provisions recently passed by Congress. The first-time homebuyers credit is 10% of the purchase price of a home, up to \$8,000, depending on filing status and income level.

“Finally, tax time, when many people receive significant refunds, is a great time to start saving for the future. Clients of DABC’s Tax SuperSites can purchase a savings bond using some of the refund we help them claim, and get started on the path to economic self-sufficiency,” concluded Cotter.
